#### Tuesday - May 7th

Cross the English Channel on board the S.S. Halladale, and following disembarkation at Calais, proceed via Dunkerque to cross the Belgian frontier for Ostend. Then proceed along the new motor highway to spend the night in Brussels where a special evening entertainment will be arranged.

#### Wednesday - May 8th

Leave Brussels and proceed via Liege to cross the German frontier at Aachen, and thus via the Moselle Valley, proceeding to Koblenz to spend the night at Darmstadt. A special reception will be given in the adjoining town of Frankfurt.

#### Thursday - May 9th

Leave Darmstadt and proceed via Wurzburg and Nornberg to spend the night at Regensburg.

#### Friday - May 10th

Continue the Rally, via Passau, crossing the Austrian Frontier and proceeding via Linz to spend two nights at Baden - a few miles outside of Vienna.

#### Saturday - May 11th

At leisure. Special sightseeing arrangements are being arranged in Vienna.

#### Sunday - May 12th

Leave Vienna and follow the northern side of the Dolomites through the Austrian Tyrol to spend the night in the ancient capital of Innsbruck.

#### Monday - May 13th

Continue the Rally through the Tyrol to cross the Arlberg Pass for Feldkirch, then across the Swiss Frontier for Zurich, to spend the night in Lucerne.

#### Tuesday - May 14th

Provided the Susten Pass is open to traffic, participants will cross the Swiss Alps for Interlaken, and a visit to Berne, the capital of Switzerland, and two nights will be spent at Lausanne.

#### Wednesday - May 15th

At leisure. Lausanne is located on the shores of Lake Geneva, and visits can be made to Geneva, Evian and Montreux by lake steamer or by road.

#### Thursday - May 16th

Leave Lausanne and cross the French Frontier to proceed through the Jura Mountains via Dole, to spend the night in Dijon.

#### Friday - May 17th

Leave Dijon and proceed on a fast, traffic-free road to Paris. Two nights will be spent in Paris and special arrangements can be made to visit some of the popular "night spots".

#### Saturday - May 18th

A special tour will be arranged for the day, followed by an optional visit to the night spot attractions.

#### Sunday - May 19th

Leave Paris and proceed to Boulogne to cross the Channel to Dover. Then proceed to London where the Rally will close with a night in the British Capital. Arrangements can be made for an evening's entertainment.

#### Monday - May 20th

At leisure.

#### Tuesday - May 21st

(a) Participants' cars to be surrendered.

(b) Tour of London including House of Commons, etc.

(c) Departure for London Airport.

#### Wednesday - May 22nd

Early morning arrival at Idlewild Airport, New York.
